Resolution Adopting Municipal Court Bond Schedule

Whereas the City maintains a Municipal Court Bond Schedule, which lists the deposit amounts to be paid by defendants in connection with municipal citations; and

Whereas the Bond Schedule requires periodic review to determine whether the deposit amounts remain appropriate; and

Whereas the City's Police Department did conduct a review of the Bond Schedule and determined that the deposit amounts were in need of revision, in that they were not commensurate with those adopted by other jurisdictions in the vicinity of Waukesha and were not a sufficient penalty to deter violations in many cases; and

Whereas the Police Department and City Attorney's Office prepared suggested revisions to the Bond Schedule to make the deposit amounts more appropriate for their deterrent purposes while promoting the efficiency of the Municipal Court; and

Whereas the Municipal Court, pursuant to its authority under Wisconsin Statutes §800.037, did revise the Bond Schedule to adopt many of the changes suggested by the Police Department and City Attorney; and

Whereas the Common Council approves of the revisions made by the Municipal Court and wishes to adopt the revised Bond Schedule as the official Bond Schedule of the City of Waukesha;

Now, therefore, the Common Council hereby resolves that the Bond Schedule attached hereto is adopted as the official Bond Schedule of the City of Waukesha, effective immediately and remaining so until further revised by the Municipal Court and Common Council.
