3. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. <u>ID#15-2487</u> Approve installation of a railroad low bridge clearance sign on

northbound Dunbar Avenue 40 feet north of Marshall Street.

Recommendation: Staff has reviewed this request and decided that only one sign needs to be installed on

Dunbar Avenue just south of the railroad bridge. This would be a warning sign for truck drivers indicating the low bridge clearance. There is other existing advance signing provided on Dunbar Avenue north and south of the railroad tracks that gives notice to

the low bridge clearance. Installation of this sign is expected to cost \$90.00 It is intended, when Dunbar Avenue is reconstructed in the future, that the warning sign

in this location will be upgraded with a flashing beacon like the warning sign on the

north side of bridge.

Recommended Motion: Move to approve installation of a railroad low bridge clearance

sign on northbound Dunbar Avenue 40 feet north of Marshall Street.

Recommendation: Engineering staff has reviewed this location for the installation of an All-Way stop

control. Staff has not collected any traffic volume or speed data on this section of road. In general, based on traffic volume patterns from other similar subdivision streets in Waukesha, the warrant for an All-Way stop sign would not be met. Staff is not in favor of installing an All-Way stop at this location and recommends no action on this item.

E. |D#15-2491 | Approve installation of 6 "No U-Turn" signs on W. St. Paul Avenue

between S. Moreland Blvd. and Washington Street placed at three locations on the eastbound direction and three locations on the

westbound direction.

Recommendation: This item was brought to B & G by the Public Works Department and the PD Parking

agents. The section of W. St. Paul from S. Moreland to Washington has many parked cars during the day and most are for the GE plant. When drivers leave the parking spots, parking agents have often seen them do a U-Turn in the middle of the street and in front of oncoming traffic. W. St. Paul is not all that wide and U-turning can cause a potential crash safety issue. Installing the No U-Turn signs will encourage drivers to go around the block and make safer maneuvers. Signs will be field located at the time of installation and ar expected to cost \$200. Staff recommends installation of these signs. Recommended Motion: Move to approve installation of 6 "No U-Turn" signs on W. St. Paul Avenue between S. Moreland Blvd. and Washington Street placed at three locations on the eastbound direction.
