Subject: Discussion and Recommendation: Establish No Parking Any Time on the east side of N. University Drive from Sunkist Ave to 340 feet south.	

Details:

Referral was made by Public Works on behalf of UW Waukesha. Activity would involve approving a No Parking Zone on University Avenue from Sunkist to the south 340 feet. The B&G committee discussed this item and requested that the item be amended to state that UWW or Waukesha County will pay for and install the signs. The committee voted unanimously for this amended item.

Options & Alternatives:

Discuss whether to approve this request. This request is tied with another request to install No Parking on University on the west side. The City would manufacture the signs and give them to UWW or Waukesha County. The County would use their forces to install the signs on their posts. The City would invoice Waukesha County for the cost of the signs.

Financial Remarks:

That total cost of installing No Parking signs under this request will be approximately \$250. Currently, the 2015 budget for Buildings & Grounds will not be able to cover this cost. Public Works staff feels that this request is being considered for UWW and benefiting their student and staff will recommend that UWW pay for the materials for the signs. So, at this time, approving this parking zone will be contingent on UWW paying for the installation and, therefore, no cost to the City. The City will not allow any signing to be installed until UWW or Waukesha County agrees to pay for it.

Executive Action:

The resolution for approving this parking zone change will need to be executed by the Mayor and Clerk after the Council Meeting.



Committee Recommendation:

The Buildings and Grounds Committee approved this item at their December 14, 2015 meeting. This item will be under the January 05, 2016 Common Council consent agenda.
