<b>Subject:</b> Approval of Resolution Supporting the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Request to Transfer Federal Surface Transportation Milwaukee Urbanized Area (STP-M) Funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha.	

**Details:**  
 This item is to seek the approval of a resolution that supports the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Request of the transfer of federal STP-M funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha. The resolution formally recognizes that the City is supporting the transfer request of funds. The City was awarded through a competitive process STP-M funds to be used for the purchase of a replacement fixed route bus. The grant provides \$368,000 in funds that will be used to replace the last 2008 bus.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
 There are no viable options. Forgoing the funds would force the City to cover a 100% of the cost of the bus vs. 20% of the cost of the bus.

**Financial Remarks:**  
 The grant will provide \$368,000 in federal STP-M funds which can cover 80% of the cost to replace the last 2008 bus which is scheduled for replacement in 2022. The remaining 20% is covered by the City.

**Executive Recommendation:**
