Subject to FTA approval, that the following 35-foot Gillig diesel buses, model year 2008, have reached the end of their useful life, are fully depreciated, and are no longer required by the City of Waukesha, and the City of Waukesha has agreed to sell the buses for \$2,500 each and transfer the title to the following buses to City of Wausau, Wisconsin:
