## Subject:

Minor Site Plan and Architectural Review – 1209 Delafield St. A request to add a new fence and reconfigure the parking area.

**Details:** Aspen Overlook is multi-family condominium development on Tenny Ave., which was approved in 2020. It includes nine four-unit buildings, for a total of 36 units. To date, only one building has been completed, along with the parking areas for the whole development.

The residents of the completed building have complained about a high volume of pedestrian traffic across the property along the north property line, between the adjacent apartment building at 1431 Big Bend Rd. and the Walgreens at 221 E. Sunset Dr. This trespassing has let to some confrontations between the pedestrians and the residents, and the applicants would like to prevent it from continuing.

They are proposing addition of a new six-foot high privacy fence along the west and north lot lines. It will run from the Tenny Ave. sidewalk to the previously approved fence in the proposed dog park area. It will be a 6' high white vinyl privacy fence. It will not continue to the south of the dog park, but the property boundaries to the south have large amounts of existing vegetation, so the applicants believe the fence will make trespassing inconvenient enough to eliminate it.

Planning Department staff approved installation of a temporary chain link fence along the property boundary in question to prevent trespassing until the proposed fence can be completed. The applicants expect to have the new fence completed this fall.
