Resolution to Reduce the Number of Members of the Public Art Committee

Whereas, the Public Art Committee was initially created as an Ad Hoc Committee during Mayor Lombardi's term of office (1998-2006), and

Whereas, in June/July of 2007, the Common Council approved the establishment of the Public Art Committee, (thereby removing the Ad Hoc designation), and furthermore on May 6, 2012, the Council unanimously approved "establishing a permanent Public Art Committee dedicated to enriching the cultural life of our community through its advocacy, encouragement and promotion of the visual arts within the City of Waukesha." and,

Whereas, the Public Art Committee presently consists of nine members, consisting of One Alderperson, two artists and six citizens, and

Whereas, the Mayor has determined that reducing the number of members of the Public Art Committee will allow the Committee to work more efficiently, allow for the easier scheduling of meetings and result in reduced problems in meeting quorums while still providing for the enriching of the cultural life of our community through advocacy, encouragement and promotion of the visual arts within the City of Waukesha.

Now, therefore, the Common Council hereby resolves that the Public Art Committee membership shall consist of one appointed Alderpersons, two artists (that are not required to reside within the city of Waukesha, but if they do not, they shall be connected to the art community within Waukesha) and three citizen members. All appointments, except for the Alderperson, shall be appointed to three-year terms. The Alderperson shall be appointed to a one-year term.

This Resolution was passed and adopted by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha the 2nd day of August 2022.
