- Recommendation:** This item was brought forward from Public Works. In 2017, the intersection of Perkins Avenue and Cleveland Avenue will be reconstructed. This item is to officially approve the installation of a stop sign on eastbound Perkins Avenue at Cleveland Avenue. Do to the complexity of the intersection and the nearby traffic signal at E. Main Street and Perkins Avenue, eastbound Perkins Avenue and southbound Cleveland Avenue will be required to stop and northbound Perkins Avenue will not stop. Staff recommends approval of this item. The associated cost for installing this signing is expected to be \$200 and funded by the construction project.
