Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling of a swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

Review and act on the request from Micheal Chrisien for a one-time sewer credit for 1516 Butler Dr.

Micheal Chrisien, on February 6, 2023, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of November, December 2022 and January 2023 for a leaking hose bib. This outdoor water use was not treated by the Clean Water Plant.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.

High Usage: 25,300 gallons (2022) and 12,800 gallons (2023)

Average Usage: 4,600 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 20,700 gallons (2022) and 8,200 gallons (2023) Calculated Refund (2022 - \$8.92/1000 gal and 2023 – \$10.48/1000 gal): \$229.55

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
