Subject: Please convert the intersection of Westowne Avenue and Brad Street to a 4-way stop.	

Details: 5/5/2025. This item was brought forward by Ald. Pieper as a referral to convert the intersection of Westowne Ave. and Brad St. from a 2-way stop to a 4-way stop. Engineering staff will present their findings along with a possible alternative.

Options & Alternatives: 1. Engineering recommends switching the stop control from Brad St. to stopping Westowne Ave. 2. The other alternative would be to make the intersection of Brad St. and Westowne Ave a 4-way stop.

Financial Remarks: If Alternative #1 is chosen, there would be no cost. The existing stop signs and posts are in good condition and could be reused. If Alternative #2 is chosen, the costs for two new stop signs and posts would be around \$250. This would be charged to the 2025 Building and Grounds Special Projects Budget (3310.54141).

Executive Recommendation: The Department of Public Works recommends keeping the intersection of Brad St and Westowne Ave a 2-way stop, but switch the stop control from Brad St. to stopping Westowne Ave.
