<b>Subject:</b> Install a Stop Sign on Navajo Lane at Fleetfoot Drive.	

**Details:**  
This item was referred by Public Works. Navajo Lane is a short street connecting E. Sunset Drive to Fleetfoot Drive. Northbound drivers on Navajo approach Fleetfoot and do not slow or attempt to yield or stop. The concerned resident has had several near misses and wants to have stop sign installed on Navajo to be sure that traffic stops first. After a field review, the Department of Public Works does not have any issues with installing a stop sign here.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

**Financial Remarks:**  
The cost of installing signs to adjust this parking zone will be about \$100 total and would be covered by the 2017 B&G Sign Budget (3310.54140).
