Mayor Reilly was present and in support of this item. He also made mention of this crosswalk being a creative art piece in the downtown area. Ald. Mike Anderson expressed concern with individuals being out in traffic to a photo opportunity and asked if it is ever to become a safety hazard or nuisance, that it is to be removed. Derrin Wolford responded to say Engineering would not condone or encourage individuals being out in the street for photo opportunities. It is to be taken in as a piece of artwork. The safety and nuisance concern can be written into the agreement. Ald. Eric Payne asked if the crosswalk is conforming if painted in this fashion. Derrin Wolford said that it would be because it still gives the message that it is a crosswalk and isn't too far from our enhance crosswalk detail. Ald. Eric Payne also asked about a removal cost that could be escrowed in case the business was to ever leave. Ald. Cory Payne expressed concern with the safety aspect similar to Ald. Mike Anderson and if this would perpetuate itself to where other business owners would want to do something similar with other crosswalks. Ald. Rick Lemke is in favor of this proposal as it provides some character and is reasonable. Ald. E Payne mentioned that if all the questions can be answered ahead of Common Council and the Council feels this is still a good idea then it can continue to move forward and not hold it for another month or longer.
