3. Discussion and Recommendation re:

A. <u>ID#16-1533</u> Consider placing a pedestrian walk on Silvernail Road at the American

Red Cross at start of the sidewalk that is on north side of road.

Recommendation: This referral was made by Ald. Bartels. A request was made to install a crosswalk

Silvernail Road approximately 140 feet west of the western most driveway to the Red Cross blood center. There is an existing bus stop on the north side of Silvernail Road at this location. The desire of the crosswalk is to connect the bus stop on the north side with sidewalks / businesses on the south side. Engineering has reviewed this location and has determined that it is not safe to place a designated crosswalk here. Eastbound drivers will not have enough time to see a person in the crosswalk and stop for them. The crosswalk would be located on the downslope side of a hill. Therefore, Public Works is not in favor of placing a crosswalk at this location. It is possible that another

location further east may be more appropriate to consider a cross walk.

B. ID#16-1534 Consider installation of marked crosswalks at the intersection of S.

Prairie Avenue and Mulberry Lane.

Recommendation: This referral was made by Ald. Manion. Currently, the intersection at S. Prairie Avenue

and Mulberry Lane is an All-Way stop. There are no painted stop bars or crosswalks. There is existing sidewalk and old curb ramps on each quadrant of the intersection. The old curb ramps are not ADA compliant. Engineering has reviewed this location and would be in favor of having new ADA compliant curb ramps installed and install new crosswalk pavement markings and stop bars. If the committee approves this item, it would be contingent on available funding. It is estimated to cost about \$5000 to install

new ramps. Currently, there is no funding source for this work.

C. <u>ID#16-1535</u>

Review and Consider Allowing Overnight Parking in the Central Business District - especially on Ann St.

Recommendation:

This referral was made by Ald. E. Payne. Residents at the Madison House Condo's at the corner of Madison & Ann Street have requested the City to allow overnight parking on Ann Street and/or Fuller Street to accommodate family members and guests who need to park overnight. The review of this has also been expanded to include all of the Central Business District. The Central Business District perimeter is defined as intersection of Wisconsin and East Ave., north on East Ave. to Main St., west to Barstow St., north to North St., southwest to Wisconsin Ave. and east to East Ave. Ann Street falls within this area. Code 7.04(6)(a) states that no overnight parking is allowed in the Central Business District. Other than Ann Street or Fuller Street, no other street in the downtown area seems appropriate to allow overnight parking. Since an ordinance would have to be changed to allow overnight parking, the Department of Public works recommends that the buildings and grounds committee refer this item to the Ordinance and License Committee.
