A. ID#17-1665 Establish No Parking Any Time on the north and south sides of Northview

Road from Meadowbrook Road to 50 feet east of the west property line of

2122 Northview Road.

Recommendation: This item was brought forward by the Department of Public Works. In 2018 and 2019,

the city will be reconstructing Northview Road from west of Pebble Valley Rd to

Meadowbrook Road. As a result of this reconstruction, the roadway width and use will change. The new roadway configuration will not have room for safe parking and will require that No Parking be established on both sides of the road. Staff recommends

approval of this item.

B. <u>ID#17-1769</u> Please approve No Parking Corner to Here on east side of S. West

Avenue from the center line of and to 50 feet north of Richard Street.

Recommendation: This item was referred by Ald. Johnson. Residents in the area using Richard Street and

turning onto S. West Avenue have difficulty seeing southbound traffic if a car is parked on the east side of S. West Avenue and north of Richard. Installing No Parking at the corner will provide more visibility for turning traffic. Staff recommends approval of this item.

Recommendation: In 2012, the owner of Waukesha Cab requested conversion of one parking stall to a taxi

cab stand. Said request was approved on April 5, 2012. The cab company has not applied for renewal of the stand and the Clerk's office has requested the taxi cab stand designation be removed. Upon removal of the designation, the parking stall will revert

back to 2 hour parking. Staff recommends approval of the item to rescind.
