Review and act on the contract for Sanitary Manhole Inspection & Condition Assessments – 2022-2025.

Details:

The Department of Public Works solicited for proposals for a consultant to inspect and assess the condition of all City owned sanitary manholes (approx. 6,400) over a four-year period. Most manholes were last inspected between 6 and 10 years ago. Four firms responded to the Request for Proposals for Technical Services. Evaluation of the responses indicated The Sigma Group, Inc., provided a quality team with the lowest cost per manhole inspected.

Options & Alternatives:

Any of other three consultants that provided a proposal could be chosen. However, the cost per manhole inspected was higher for each and every year of the project duration for each of the other consultants.

2022: 1600 manholes x \$30/manhole = \$48,000.00 2023: 1600 manholes x \$31/manhole = \$49,600.00 2024: 1600 manholes x \$32/manhole = \$51,200.00 2025: 1600 manholes x \$33/manhole = \$52,800.00
