

Review and Act on New Agreement with Google for Google Transit

#### Details:

This item is to seek the approval for a new agreement with Google for sharing transit data with Google for Google Transit. The Transit System is now able to share real time GPS data with Google through our new AVL system which will allow Google to show Waukesha Metro buses in real time on Google Transit when users are looking to plan a bus trip through Google Transit. When the original agreement was made with Google back in 2014, real time data sharing was not an option and was not part of the agreement. The new agreement includes sharing of real time data and hence the need for the new agreement.
