Dear Plan Commission:

Berg Management Company (Developer) asks that you review the attached proposal for 330 E. North St. and the former City parking lot at the corner of Barstow and Buena Vista.

Developer owns land at 330 E. North St. and plans to purchase the old parking lot from the City of Waukesha and combine the two properties via CSM – a Letter of Intent has already been submitted to the City of Waukesha to purchase the old City Hall parking lot. Developer would then plan to build a 77-unit apartment complex. This complex would be a mix of one- and two-bedroom apartments, with one studio, and several townhomes stepping up the hill, with city views. There would be 128 underground, in building, parking stalls, on two levels, and a large amount of amenity space including balconies, a roof deck, a community room, and a fitness room.

Berg Management has contracted with AG Architecture for conceptual drawings and renderings (attached). The building would be of wood construction with concrete in the parking garages. The exterior would consist of black brick, cement board, and metal panels.
