


Current Organization

Challenges and Opportunities

Challenges:

- Acceptance of staff
- Potential less control from City Council
- Transferring large Clean Water Plant cash balance to Water Utility from City
- Possible communication challenges with road, water, sewer reconstruction
- Benefit differences between Water Utility and General City Employees

Challenges and Opportunities

Opportunities:

- Increased efficiency and coordination on water and wastewater projects/issues
- Better coordination on Lake Michigan water issues
 - Currently Clean Water Plant is responsible for <u>water quality</u> of water discharged to Fox River and Root River
 - Water Utility is responsible for the <u>volume</u> of water returned to Great Lakes and the <u>water quality</u> within the Root River
- Less overlap between staff
- Rate setting authority with water/sewer commission
- Decrease in administrative redundancies

Recommendation

 Authorize organizational study of the Public Works Department to Determine if Clean Water Plant Division should combine with Water Utility
