Re: Request for Approval of Change Order No. 003 for CP2A

As part of the Great Water Alliance Contract Package 2A (Supply Pipeline), Super Excavators has requested the following Change Order for approval. This change order is primarily quantity adjustments to amend bid items to the as-constructed quantities. The net result of this change order is an increase of \$1,293,043.88.

The largest cost item on this change order is CO 3.10 Disposal of Impacted Soil – Priegel Drive in the amount of \$895,000.00. This is related to work on CP6 where the contractor hauled over 25,000 tons of spoil material that was later determined to be contaminated to a fill site. Therefore, the material needed to be hauled to an approved dump site. The estimate for that work from the CP5 contractor was not desirable so we obtained a cost from the CP2A contractor which was much more economical.

Also, the last five items listed are related to Milwaukee County permit requirement changes for lawn restoration.

Detailed supporting documentation with a detailed description of each change order item is enclosed with this memo. Along with our Construction Management team, I have reviewed and approve of this Change Order request.

**Recommended Motion:** Move to approve the noted Change Order for Contract Package 2A for a net total of \$1,293,043.88 and no additional days.

# **Contract Description**

## **Project Overview:**

Waukesha Water Utility (WWU) provides water treatment and distribution services to the City of Waukesha and isolated portions of the Town of Waukesha. WWU owns and operates a system of wells that pumps groundwater from the St. Peter Sandstone Aquifer for treatment and then to WWU's distribution system. The St. Peter Sandstone Aquifer, which has been the primary source of drinking water for not only the City of Waukesha but for communities throughout the Midwest, is being depleted in southeast Wisconsin. This depletion is due in large part to a natural layer of shale rock that restricts groundwater recharge. Depletion of the St. Peter Sandstone Aquifer has also caused increases in the concentrations of radium and other contaminants. As a result, the City of Waukesha needs a long-term, sustainable alternative to its existing water supply to protect public health.

The purpose of the Great Lakes Water Supply Program is to provide a new primary water supply to the City of Waukesha by connecting the city to the Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) supply system. The Department of Justice (DOJ) has placed restrictions on the Program which state that the Program must certify to the DOJ that all project construction is under contract and is 50 percent complete by May 1, 2022. In addition, certification that the Program has completed compliance with all federal and state drinking water radionuclide standards shall be provided by September 1, 2023.

#### **Description of Change, Alteration or Modification:**

#### Item Nos. CO-03.01

The following Change Order Item includes a cost credit for installing Type 304 Stainless Steel Bolts on six blow-off gate valves in lieu of Type 304L or Type 316 Stainless Steel, as detailed in Work Change Directive No. 006. The acceptance of these changes results in a net decrease of \$3,000.00 to the Contract Price.

#### Item Nos. CO-03.02

The following Change Order Item includes all labor, materials, and equipment costs associated with the signal head and conduit repair at 124th Street and National Avenue, as detailed in Change Order Request No. 015. The acceptance of these changes results in a net increase of \$4,848.00 to the Contract Price.

#### Item Nos. CO-03.03

The following Change Order Item includes all labor, materials, and equipment costs associated with installing a 20-Inch Water Supply Pipeline, Direct Buried Butterfly Valve, as detailed in Change Order Request No. 016. The acceptance of these changes results in a net increase of \$18,000.00 to the Contract Price.

#### Item Nos. CO-03.04 through CO-03.08

The following Change Order Items include all labor, materials and equipment costs to adjust the original Contract Bid Tab Line Items indicated to As-Constructed Quantities. The acceptance of these changes results in a net increase of \$258,486.00 to the Contract Price.

The following Change Order Item includes all labor, materials, and equipment costs associated with furnishing a spare 30-inch Water Supply Pipeline mechanical joint butterfly valve, as detailed in Change Order Request No. 018. The acceptance of these changes results in a net increase of \$19,982.00 to the Contract Price.

#### Purpose for this Work Change Directive:

The purpose of Work Change Directive No. 006 is to provide a cost credit to Owner on blow-off gate valve bolt material.

#### **Description of Change:**

Contract Documents specify using Type 304L or Type 316 Stainless Steel Bolts for gate valves. Contractor installed Type 304 Stainless Steel Bolts on five blow-off gate valves and has one ready for installation. Contractor has agreed to provide a \$500.00 credit per blow-off gate valve to keep the Type 304 Stainless Steel Bolts.

The impacted gate valves are on the following blow-off assemblies: BO-WS11, BO-WS10, BO-WS09, BO-WS08, BO-WS06, BO-WS07 (ready for installation).

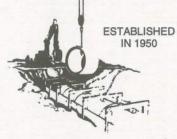

Reference is made to your February 15, 2022 Change Order Request, received via PMWeb on February 15, 2022. Excavators, Inc. has submitted a request for an adjustment to the Contract Price through Change Order Request No. 017. Super Excavators, Inc. has requested an increase to the Contract Price of \$131,555.00 to restore areas of Milwaukee County jurisdiction with sod restoration as required by the permit in lieu of seed restoration.

Super Excavators, Inc. is requesting \$122,880.00 to restore 6,000 square yards of landscaped areas with sod, or \$20.48 per square yard. Additionally, Contractor is requesting \$8,675.00 for 25 million gallons to water the placed sod, or \$347.00 per million gallons. Contractor to submit final quantity of sod placed and water used for review and payment. Upon completion of sod restoration work within Milwaukee County jurisdiction, unused units of Contract Items 17-WS-I, 17-WS-II, and 17-WS-III will be removed from the contract. The Unit Price for Landscape, Wetland, and Agricultural Restoration Contract Items 17-WS-I, 17-WS-II, and 17-WS-III is \$15 per square yard, \$15 per square yard, respectively.
