- 1. Loan maximum of \$300,000 at 1.75% simple interest with payments starting in December 2023.
- 2. Applicant shall obtain a minimum of two estimates/bids for the work.
- 3. Applicant will receive loan funds as project costs are incurred with options for how funds would be dispersed: either the applicant pays contractors and submits paid invoices to us for reimbursement, or the City can make direct payment to contractors upon applicant authorization that the work was completed
- 4. Interest only accrues on money spent, not the full \$300,000.
- 5. The loan would be repaid over a 5-year period with the first payment due December 31, 2023.
- 6. Annual interest payments much be paid prior to Dec 2023. The motion carried by the following vote:
