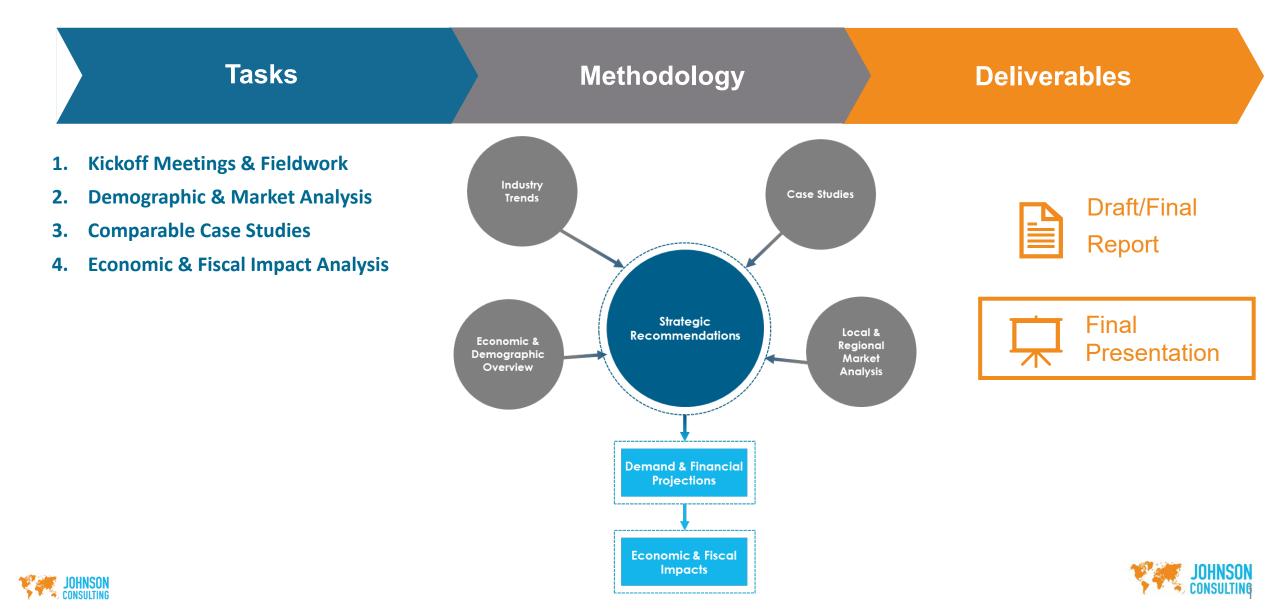

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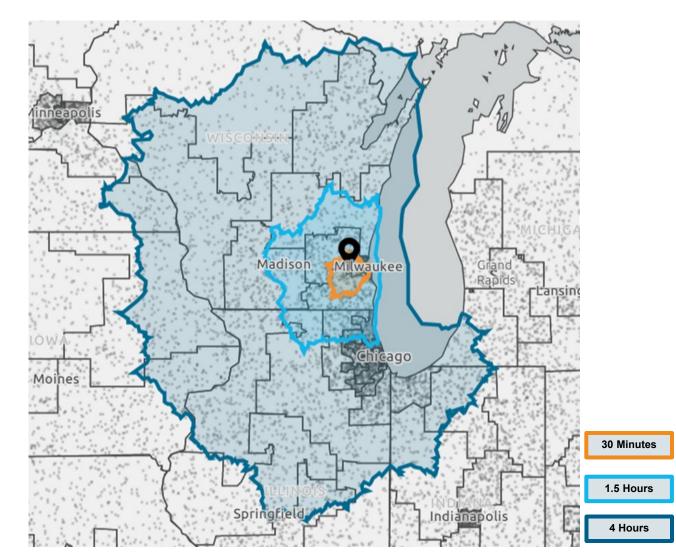

Section 3 Program Validation & Market Penetration

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Program Validation

- The proposed facility will be a major attractor for the Waukesha market, which is already a sports-centric destination. Many interviewees view the proposed project as appropriate, as there is a need and desire for additional turf fields.
- There is a perceived need and desire for outdoor multipurpose fields, particularly artificial turf playing surfaces, in Waukesha and the surrounding area. Multiple interviewees stated that it is anticipated that there would be considerable demand for these fields with protentional camps and clinics, as well as practice and possible tournaments.
- The location of the proposed project is suitable for many local clubs, and the proximity to major markets such as Milwaukee and Madison would help to draw demand for regional and even statewide tournaments and events.
- Milwaukee Wave Soccer Club has expressed interest in serving as an anchor tenant for the project, however they have also raised concerns regarding the need for multiple turf fields that are well lit. This would allow for extended hours of use, as well as lower maintenance costs and higher quality playing conditions.
- It is critical that the fields be multi-purpose, flexible and adaptable. This could be achieved by multiple striping
 options for different sports use, as well as the ability for fields to be resized for different age groups.
- Regionally, the most attractive facilities are the Uihlein Soccer Complex in Milwaukee and Reddan Soccer Park in Verona.

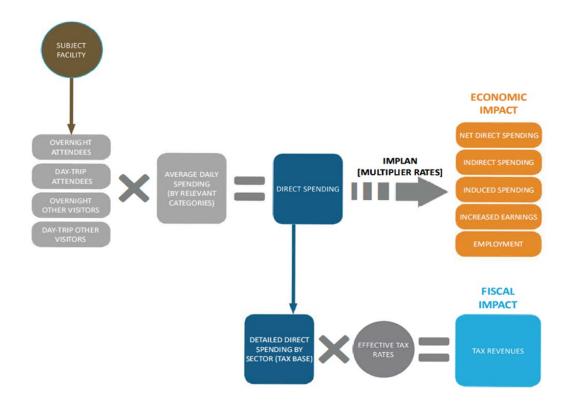
