At the Great Water Alliance outfall site where the return flow discharges into the Root River, an existing house was located within the property we purchased. As you know, this house was relocated by the previous owner this past winter. The City of Franklin contacted us to coordinate permits needed to perform the remaining site demolition and clearing. The required work included: well abandonment, septic tank removal, basement foundation removal, driveway pavement removal, general debris removal, site grading, and restoration. Following that, WWU requested a quote for the scope of work from S.J. Louis and received a cost of \$65,000. We then decided it was in the best interest of the utility to obtain additional quotes.

Six different demolition and excavating companies were contacted, however only one responded with a firm quote and had availability to perform the scope of work. Macemon and Sons, Inc. was engaged to perform this work after submitting a quote of \$17,000. The Water Commission was notified of this on May 6th to gain approval on moving forward with this contract.

All proper permits were obtained from the City of Franklin and work commenced on May 18th. Some additional work beyond the scope was needed to complete the work, including tree removal and additional site grading. The additional work was in part, due to preparing the site for agricultural use. On June 6th, I received an invoice from the contractor in the amount of \$22,458.00. After discussions with the contractor, I have confirmed this cost is justified.

Recommended Motion: Move to ratify and approve of the payment for this work in the amount of \$22,458.00 to Macemon and Sons, Inc.
