Resolution Accepting Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Center
Grant Award from Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction

Whereas The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) solicited grant applications for the Nita M. Lowey 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC), and

Whereas the City of Waukesha, through its Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department submitted a grant application for Hawthorne Elementary School, and

Whereas the 21st CCLC grant program supports academic support, recreation and youth development programs during after-school hours/15-hour summer program, and

Whereas the City of Waukesha through its Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department operates such a program at Hawthorne Elementary School, and

Whereas the DPI has expressed an intention to award funds to the City of Waukesha Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department to support its after-school/15-hour summer recreation programming for the 2022-2023 school year, and

Whereas with evidence of satisfactory implementation of the program, DPI intends to award an annual grant for a five-year period,

Now Therefore, the Common Council of the City of Waukesha resolves that the City of Waukesha shall accept the 21st Century Community Learning Center grant for programming at Hawthorne Elementary School for the 2022-2023 school year and for each subsequent school year in the five-year period in which the grant is awarded to the City of Waukesha.
