Review and Act on Resolution Supporting the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Request to Transfer Federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha

#### Details:

This item is to review and act on a resolution that supports the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Request of the transfer of federal CMAQ funds from the Federal Highway Administration to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Waukesha. The resolution formally recognizes that the City is supporting the transfer request of funds. The City was awarded through a competitive process. The CMAQ funds would be used to purchase nine replacement bus engines that are part of the mid-life bus rehab program. The engine replacements are proposed to be replaced in the following schedule: 5 in 2023, 2 in 2024 and 2 in 2025. The grant provides \$222,400 in federal funds to pay of 80% of the cost of nine replacement engines.

The City will receive a total of \$222,400 in federal funds that will pay for 80% of the replacement engines.
