From the inception of a project we take you from initial sketches and concepts through the installation and unveiling of the project.

<u>CONSULTATION</u> One of our key management personnel will meet with you to discuss the scope of your project. Upon communicating your ideas and answering your questions, we will provide you with a price and cost breakdown of materials, engraving services, accessories, construction and installation work. We will also provide a detailed timeline required for each phase of the project. If this appeals to you, the project becomes much more of our baby than yours. We will make sure that no aspect is overlooked and provide the best possible outcome.

<u>CREATE PLANS</u> Based on the consultation, and our understanding of the scope of the project along with any inspiration examples you provide, our experienced design team will provide design options with emphasis on functionalionality, longevity and minimal maintenance using materials that withstand the elements of nature.

<u>LIFE LIKE RENDERINGS</u> Our draftsmen will then create detailed 3D renderings from various vantage points using multiple material options, allowing you to vividly visualize the project. We will also provide a comprehensive video rendering as well as night lights rendering.

<u>SCOPE OF WORK</u> We will provide an extensive Scope of Work document for the project. This will map out the entire step-by-step process we will take to complete our project, including material specifications, production planning, engraving and artwork details, onsite work such as excavation, foundation, installation, plumbing, electrical plans and maintenance plans.

<u>DETAILED BUDGET</u> At the end of the Scope of Work will be the detailed Budget Items Worksheet, which shows the price breakdown for individual items. This will help you understand the total cost of your project.

REVIEW & PROPOSAL MEETING On average, it takes us about 2 weeks to complete the designing process and compile the Scope of Work and Budget documents. When the designs are complete, we will send them for your review. At this stage our goal is to review and finalize the material and manufacturing related plans. This will help us start the material sourcing and manufacturing at the factory. Since this is the longest chain of the entire project we will commence work on this as fast as possible. Any design and artwork related changes can be accommodated and revised for approval until the completion of the manufacturing portion of the monument.

OBTAINING REGULATORY APPROVALS AND PERMITS We will work with the appropriate agencies to obtain the regulatory approvals and permits.



<u>CONSTRUCTION</u> Once all the major material and construction plans are approved by you and the permits are obtained we will commence the onsite construction work. This includes excavation, concrete foundation, masonry work, landscaping work, electrical and plumbing work. This work will be dependent upon the weather conditions. We will keep you updated regarding the progress made with timely and detailed photos and notifications.

<u>MONUMENT ENGRAVING</u> After the approval of the artwork, names, dates, verses and all messages of significance we will engrave the monument using sandblasting, cnc milling and cnc laser engraving processes. There are some elements that will involve comprehensive sculpting and crafting work that are done manually. We will have your final approval before we start personalizing the monument.

<u>INSTALLATION</u> Once the site construction work is complete we will ship the materials to the construction site from our facilities. We will arrange heavy duty construction equipment to unload and install the monuments according to the approved plans.

<u>FINISHING TOUCH</u> After the installation is complete we install the accessories made of stainless steel, bronze or porcelain to provide that final finishing touch to the monument. We make sure every part of the monument is completed to your satisfaction.

<u>COMMUNITY OWNERSHIP</u> The biggest part and the main purpose of a memorial project is its ability to excite and bring the community together to own that project. We will assist in strategies to involve citizens of all age groups to participate in the project. We help with planning and execution of the unveiling ceremony with marketing materials, promotions, commemorative products.



OPTION 1 SIDE - 1 ENGRAVING DETAILED VIEW








