Subject:

Review and act on the two-party State Municipal Agreement between the City of Waukesha and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation regarding the Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP) Supplemental Program grant for the reconstruction of Delafield Street between Prospect Avenue and Magnolia Drive.

Details:

In 2021, the City applied for grant funding for the reconstruction of Delafield Street from Prospect Avenue to Magnolia Drive as part of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP) – Supplemental. In, 2022, the City received approval to enter a State Municipal Agreement (SMA) for construction reimbursement for this project not to exceed \$1,630,000.00. The reconstruction of Delafield Street is planned to occur in 2023 pending the approval of the 2023 Community Investment Program (CIP).

As part of the State Municipal Agreement, the Delafield St. project must be completed and reimbursement applied for prior to June 30, 2027 or the funds will be allocated to a different municipality.
