Please study and act on the need for additional pedestrian signage at Blackhawk Trail and Sunset.

Details:

6/5/2023. This item was brought forward by Ald. M. Payne as a referral to study and act on the need for additional pedestrian signage at Sunset Drive and Blackhawk Trail. Engineering staff have reviewed this request and do not have an issue with installing additional pedestrian crossing signage on Sunset Drive for the pedestrian crossing at Blackhawk Trail as well as installing a speed limit sign for eastbound Sunset Drive east of Guthrie Road.

Options & Alternatives: None

Financial Remarks:

The cost for installing one (1) speed limit sign, three (3) pedestrian crossing signs, two (2) downward pointing arrow plaques, one (1) ahead plaque, and four (4) sign poles would be around \$540 and covered by the 2023 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).

Executive Recommendation:

The Department of Public Works recommends installing an eastbound speed limit sign on Sunset Drive east of Guthrie Road, installing pedestrian warning signs for eastbound Sunset Drive at Blackhawk Trail, and installing an additional pedestrian crossing sign for westbound Sunset Drive at Blackhawk Trail on the south side of Sunset Drive.
