## Subject:

Establish various no parking zones, removal of a no parking zone, and extension of a 2-hr parking zone (with restrictions) because of various bus route modifications.

## Details:

6/5/2023. This item was brought forward by the Engineering Department as a referral to establish the below listed no parking zones and the removal of a no parking zone because of various bus route modifications:

- Establish no parking on the east side of S. Hartwell Avenue from 30' north of E. Laflin Avenue to 110' south of E. Laflin Avenue.
- Establish "2-hour parking 8:00am to 4:00pm September 1 to June 1 except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays" on the west side of S. Hartwell Avenue from E. College Avenue to E. Laflin Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the north side of Lincoln Avenue from Oakland Avenue to 75' east of Oakland Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the south side of Lincoln Avenue from Oakland Avenue to 125' west of Oakland Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the north side of Lincoln Avenue from Bell Street to 70' east of Bell Street.
- Establish no parking on the south side of Lincoln Avenue from 20' west of Bell Street to 40' east of Bell Street.
- Establish no parking on the south side of Progress Avenue from S. Prairie Avenue to 150' west of S. Prairie Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the south side of E. Broadway from Oakland Avenue to 90' west of Oakland Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the east side of Nike Drive from E. Main Street to 220' south of E. Main Street.
- Rescind the existing bus stop no parking zone on the south side of Mac Arthur Road west of the Bike Trail.

Options & Alternatives: None	

Financial Remarks:	

The cost for installing twelve (12) no parking signs and two (2) sign poles would be around \$470 and covered by the 2023 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).

## **Executive Recommendation:**

The Department of Public Works recommends the approval of the additional no parking restrictions and 2-hour parking restriction as listed under the Details section.
