BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes shall place the following official traffic signs and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

The following resolution was approved at the June 5, 2023, Building and Grounds meeting and brought forward to the June 20, 2023, Common Council Meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

- ID#23-6601: Install stop ahead signs and "Traffic on Summit Does Not Stop" signs underneath the stop ahead signs for northbound and southbound Washington Street approaching Summit Avenue.
- ID#23-6887: Install truck route signage on eastbound and westbound USH 18/STH 59 to direct trucks to utilize West Avenue north of USH 18/STH 59 instead of Center Road and install truck route signage on westbound Sunset Drive to direct trucks to utilize Industrial Lane instead of Prairie Avenue.
- ID#23-6888: Install a pedestrian crossing sign for westbound Sunset Drive at Blackhawk Trail on the south side of Sunset Drive.
- ID#23-6889: Install a no U-turn/left turn sign for the North Street slip lane at Albert Street.
- ID#23-6890: Rescind the previously approved ID#16-167 of "Install a sign that says 'Right Lane Must Turn Right Except for Transit Buses' on westbound Abbott Drive at Parklawn Drive."

ID#23-6891:

- Establish no parking on the east side of S. Hartwell Avenue from 30' north of E. Laflin Avenue to 110' south of E. Laflin Avenue, establish "2-hour parking 8:00am to 4:00pm September 1 to June 1 except Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays" on the west side of S. Hartwell Avenue from E. College Avenue to E. Laflin Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the north side of Lincoln Avenue from Oakland Avenue to 75' east of Oakland Avenue, establish no parking on the south side of Lincoln Avenue from Oakland Avenue to 125' west of Oakland Avenue.
- Establish no parking on the north side of Lincoln Avenue from Bell Street to 70' east of Bell Street, establish no parking on the south side of Lincoln Avenue from 20' west of Bell Street to 40' east of Bell Street.
- Establish no parking on the south side of Progress Avenue from S. Prairie Avenue to 150' west of S. Prairie Avenue
- Establish no parking on the south side of E. Broadway from Oakland Avenue to 90' west of Oakland Avenue
- Establish no parking on the east side of Nike Drive from E. Main Street to 220' south of E. Main Street
- Rescind the existing bus stop no parking zone on the south side of Mac Arthur Road west of the Bike Trail

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall file this resolution in their office as part of the original City records.
