PROCLAMATION PARK AND RECREATION MONTH

WHEREAS, parks and recreation is an integral part of communities throughout this country, including the City of Waukesha; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation promotes health and wellness, improving the physical and mental health through the City's 50 parks; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation promotes time spent in nature in over 1,100 acres of dedicated City Park and Open Space, which positively impacts mental health by increasing cognitive performance and well-being, and reduces stress and symptoms of depression, attention deficit disorders, and Alzheimers; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation encourages physical activities in Waukesha by providing and programming at 3 sports complexes, 43 fields and 75 courts for popular sports, 12 miles of hiking trails, 2 outdoor swimming pools and many other attractions designed to promote active lifestyles; and

WHERAS, parks and recreation strengthens community image and sense of place through 5,000+ Park rentals, 38 special events, 1500+ Volunteers (22,000+ hours annually), 272 community partnerships; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation partners to provide 10,000 healthy meals in the summer, nutrition services and education year round; and

WHEREAS, park and recreation programming and education activities, such as before/afterschool programming at 10 of our elementary schools, youth sports and environmental education, are critical to childhood development; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation increases a community's economic prosperity through increased property values, expansion of the local tax base, increased tourism, the attraction and retention of businesses, and crime reduction; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation is fundamental to the environmental well-being of our community managing 24,000 Street Trees and 3,200 Park Trees; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation is essential and adaptable infrastructure that makes our communities resilient in the face of natural disasters and climate change; and
