<b>Subject:</b> Review and act on the Contract extension with United Liquid Waste for bio-solids hauling for the City's Clean Water Plant.	

**Details:**  
 United Liquid Waste has offered a contract extension for hauling bio-solids for the City's Clean Water Plant. They would hold the 2023/2024 rate at \$27.50 per ton, should the City decide to exercise that option. United Liquid Waste has been contracted with the City for the last 13 years and has done a satisfactory job and is familiar with our processes and requirements. The current contract was started in 2023.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
 The contract has an option to renew or the City may re-bid the contract. Re-bidding may result in a higher price. The overall CPI for transportation increased 4.10% since the original contract was signed. Based on this, we believe re-bidding would result in higher costs for sludge hauling.

**Financial Remarks:**  
 Sludge disposal is charged to account number 7388.53910 which has \$168,300 budgeted for 2024. The City paid United Liquid Waste \$124,900.62 in 2024 for bio-solids hauling.

**Executive Recommendation:**  
 Recommend approval of the contract extension with United Liquid Waste for bio-solids hauling for the City's Clean Water Plant at \$27.50 per ton.
