Our recipient is Philip and Chenoah Olson. They have a 9 year old son named Jonah. Philip was an Army Specialist for 4 years and 11 months before he was medically retired from the Army. Philip was shot 3 times, and was also thrown from a vehicle from and IED blast. He suffers from PTSD, TBI, and lower back and leg issues. He is currently a student working towards a degree. This home will give him the ability for him and his wife to finish their schooling, take care of their son and begin new careers.

I anticipate the normal cost to construct the home at \$313,000 and currently after donations I expect our cost to be around \$93, 743. This number will change as we are still getting donations on some parts of the home. The home will be built through generous donations of materials and labor from local and national contractors and suppliers. The remainder of the cost of the home will be covered by donations and fundraising activities on behalf of Operation Finally Home. The home will be provided to Philip and his family at zero cost to him.

Operation Finally Home is a 501c3 based in Texas and Belman Builders will be the general contractor running the project. This will be the 2nd Operation Finally Home project we have done in Wisconsin. I guarantee this will be one of the most rewarding projects you will ever be a part of!
