

## **Resolution to Designate United States Bike Route 30 (USBR 30) On City of Waukesha Streets**

**Whereas**, bicycle tourism is a growing industry in North America, contributing \$47 billion a year to the economies of communities that provide facilities for such tourists; and

**Whereas**, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) has designated a United States bike route corridor and has proposed a part of that corridor crossing central Wisconsin to be developed as United States Bike Route 30 (USBR 30); and

**Whereas**, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), the Wisconsin Bike Federation, and the Adventure Cycling Association have proposed a specific route, in Wisconsin and in Waukesha County to be designated as USBR 30, a map of which is herein incorporated into this resolution by reference; and

**Whereas**, the proposed route for USBR 30 will travel through the City of Waukesha by means of the existing Glacial Drumlin and New Berlin Trail on-street connector route; and can, therefore, provide a benefit to our residents and businesses; and

**Whereas**, we have investigated the proposed route and found it to be a suitable route, and desire that the route be designated so that it can be mapped and signed, thereby promoting bicycle tourism in our area.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Waukesha hereby expresses its approval and support for the development of USBR 30, and requests that the appropriate officials see to it that the route is officially designated by AASHTO as soon as this can be achieved, and authorizes the posting of signs within Waukesha right-of-way identifying the route through the community once the official designation has been made.


