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A Resolution Approving and Adopting the Amendment of the Project Plan for Tax Incremental District 9

Whereas the Plan Commission having previously approved and adopted the original Project Plan for Tax Incremental District 9 on September 22, 1993, and the City subsequently having approved and adopted the Project Plan on November 2, 1993; and

Whereas Wis. Stats. §66.1105(6)(f) allows the Plan Commission to amend the Project Plan for a Tax Incremental District (TID) to allow the allocation of positive tax increments to another Tax Incremental District, provided certain conditions are met; and

Whereas the Plan Commission having reviewed a financial analysis of TID 9 and having determined that the District will have positive tax increments after all expenditures are made in 2017; and

Whereas TID 16 is an active district and is eligible to receive increment donations; and

Whereas the amendment of the Project Plan for TID 9 having required a public hearing, and such public hearing having taken place after the publication of a Class 1 Legal Notice on August 16, 2016; and

Whereas the Plan Commission having heard and considered public comment on the matter, having heard and considered the presentation of the Department of Community Development, and having read and considered the proposed amendment to the Project Plan for TID 9, and being fully advised on the matter;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Plan Commission, pursuant to the authority of Wis. Stats. $\S66.1105(4)(h)(1)$ and $\S66.1105(6)(f)$:

- 1. The Plan Commission makes the following findings:
 - a. Neither TID 9 nor 16 has terminated.
 - **b.** Both TIDs 9 and 16 have identical overlying taxing jurisdictions.
 - **c.** TID 16 was created upon a finding that not less than 50 percent, by area, of the real property in the district is blighted or in need of rehabilitation.

- **d.** TID 9 has satisfied in 2016, and will satisfy in 2017, all of its current-year debt-service and project-cost obligations.
- **e.** After amendment, the TID 9 Project Plan will be feasible and in conformity with the City's Comprehensive Plan.
- f. A public hearing concerning the amendment of the TID 9 Project Plan was held on August 16, 2016, after publication of a Class 1 notice under Chapter 985, which contained a statement of the purpose and cost of the amendment, and which advised that a copy of the amendment would be provided on request.
- g. The Class 1 notice was also delivered by first-class mail to the chief executive officers or administrators of all local governmental entities having the power to levy taxes on property within TID 9 and to the school board of all school districts having property within TID 9.
- 2. The Tax Incremental District 9 Project Plan Amendment, as presented by the Department of Community Development, is approved and adopted in its entirety.
- 3. This Resolution shall be submitted to the Common Council with the recommendation of the Plan Commission that the Common Council adopt a resolution approving and adopting the Tax Incremental District 9 Project Plan Amendment as presented by the Department of Community Development.
