



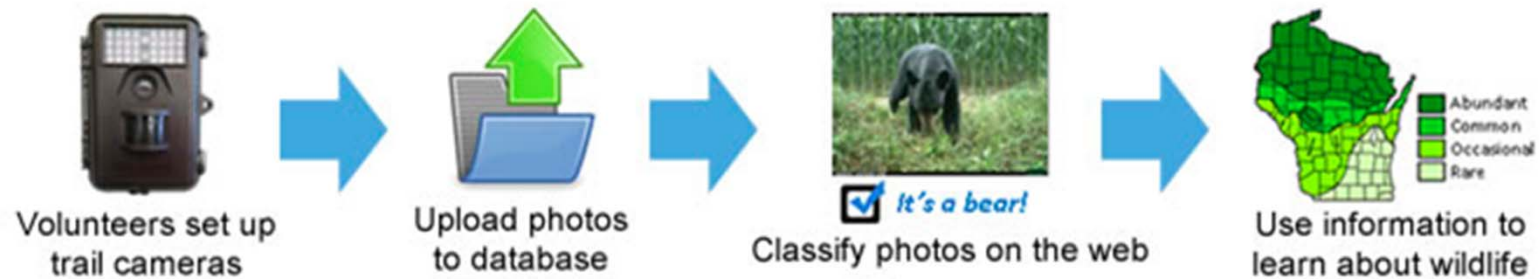

## ***Snapshot Wisconsin*** Trail Camera for SDW
