Subject:

Establish No Parking This Side of Street on the north south side of Wood Street from S. West Avenue to Waverly Place.

Details:

This referral was made by Public Works. Wood Street is a narrow street and, when vehicles are parked on both sides, vehicles such as emergency, snow plow and garbage have difficulty going down the street. The request is to not allow parking on the north side of the street. The committee discussed this item and Ald. Jankowski motioned to amend the item to state "on the south side of Wood Street" rather than on the north side. The committee agreed to the change and the motion for approval read: "Establish No Parking This Side of Street on the south side of Wood Street from S. West Avenue to Waverly Place.

The committee voted unanimously to approve the amended item.
