Subject:

Rescind the existing 2 Hour parking zone on the south side of E. St. Paul Avenue from 475 east of Albert Street to 770 feet west of E. Moreland Blvd.

Details:

This referral was made by Ald. Payne. The request is remove an existing 2 hour parking zone on the south side of E. St. Paul Avenue adjacent to the Metal Tek factory. The result is to sign and create an area for loading / unloading for Metal Tek trucks in the same spot.

The Department of Public Works does not have any issue with removing this 2 hour parking zone as long as it is replaced with a similar restriction and does not revert to open parking. Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.
