Metal-Era, 1600 Airport Road - Final Site Plan & Architectural Review

Details:

Metal Era is requesting Final Site and Architectural approval for Phase 2 of their three-phase addition project at their facility at 1600 Airport Road. The first phase had some minor building modifications and parking lot expansion and was approved in 2015. This phase includes the construction of a 26,277 square foot addition onto the east side of their western building The building will be constructed of precast concrete panels with some accent striping that ties into the accent stripes on the existing building. There will also be new loading docks added onto the east side of the existing building, just south of the new addition.

This phase will also include the creation of an expanded parking lot along Aviation Drive and additional employee parking along the north side of the parcel. There will be a new entrance drive along Airport Road. A significant amount of landscaping along the property frontage is also proposed with this phase.
