<b>Subject:</b> <b>404 Mainstream Bar, 404 Main Street – Final Site Plan &amp; Architectural Review</b>	

#### Details:

Mainstream Bar is proposing an addition of a deck for outdoor seating in the rear of the property adjacent to the municipal parking lot. In addition, the proposed deck would serve as access to the second floor apartments.

Staff has two main concerns with this proposal. First, the Chief Building Inspector and Fire Marshall are working with the applicant to ensure compliant and adequate egress paths from the upper apartments. Secondly, the proposed location of the dumpsters and grease trap is on city property and one is directly in front of electrical meters. The applicant is working with city staff to identify a solution for the dumpsters.

#### Options & Alternatives:

Options discussed for the dumpsters include: use of the existing shared dumpster on the east end of the parking lot, petitioning for use of the public row for one of the dumpsters or grease trap and building an enclosure surrounding it, explore the possibility of constructing a second shared dumpster on the west end of the municipal lot to be shared by multiple businesses.
