



BUSINESS CONSULTING SERVICES



The Center for Growth's Business Consultant helped with the launch of 3 new ventures with capital investments totaling \$171,000. The Center also organized 2 workshops on woman- and minority-owned business certification and growing new business through government contracting.

The Business Consultant developed strong relationships with 3 new resource partners to increase community awareness of the Center's consulting services in Waukesha County, among Asian American professionals in the Milwaukee metropolitan area and in the regional food and beverage industry.

This exceeds Q1 by 15%.

31 of these are new outreach connections.

33% of these (excluding lenders) are members of the Alliance.

Of the 40 businesses served in Q2, excluding lenders, 75% have signed on as clients. 20 companies are now long-term clients, or have received 5 or more counseling hours.

Consulting work totaled 218 hours, a 7% increase over Q1.

Schools2Skills™ dates, the MADE career fair date and the Many Futures in Health Care Career Expo date for the 2017-2018 academic school year were announced to all Waukesha County school districts, in partnership with the Waukesha County Business Alliance's Education Policy Committee and Manufacturing Alliance groups.

participants from around the country, including the Center for Growth's Talent and Education Manager, were accepted into the Talent Pipeline Management Academy facilitated by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce. The Academy consists of workshops led by the U.S. Chamber Foundation for business professionals to receive instruction on talent pipeline strategies including curriculum, technical assistance and a peer-to-peer learning network. The first session takes place in July in Washington D.C.

Pro Trade Job Development is a pre-apprenticeship construction trade training program that teaches participants the basic technical skills needed to get a job in the construction industry. This program is in partnership with Mindful Staffing Solutions, an organization that instills professional and personal development skills that are necessary to keep a job and turn it into a career. Both organizations recently presented to the Waukesha County Business Alliance's Education **Construction Committee to discuss the** potential for expanding the program in
