Review and act on the proposed 2018 Sanitary Sewer rates

Details:

Jon Cameron, Municipal Advisor with Ehlers & Associates, Inc., has prepared our annual sewer rate model for the past ten years. His model includes a detailed cost of service study for 2018, and an updated long-range cash flow analysis with a revised capital improvement plan.

Financial Remarks:

A sewer rate increase with an effective date of January 1, 2018 is necessary to ensure adequate revenue to fund operations, maintenance and capital improvements for the treatment plant and collection system in the upcoming year. The annual cost for the average residential user will increase by 9.61%. The recommended rate increase supports and maintains the City's 125% debt coverage requirement.

Approve the proposed 2018 Sanitary Sewer rates.
