(4) EMERGENCY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS. (Am. #9-09) In case of <u>Temporary Traffic</u> Regulations.

- (a) Where emergency or other special circumstance that requires action in the public interest exists, the Chief of Police or his or her designee may make and enforce temporary emergency traffic regulations to cover special conditions. prohibiting, limiting the time of, or otherwise restricting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on City streets. Such regulations shall only be in force for the duration of the emergency or special circumstance, and shall terminate immediately upon the cessation of the emergency or special circumstance.
- During street, alley or other right_of_way construction, the Director of Public Works may authorize temporary traffic regulations as conditions may necessitate. The Director shall inform the Chief of Police of the temporary regulations and the anticipated time the temporary regulations shall be in effect.
- Any time a temporary regulation is imposed pursuant to this subsection (4), signs shall be posted giving public notice that the regulation is in effect, and specifying the acts that are restricted by the regulation sufficient to give reasonable notice so that the public may comply.
- (d) Any time a regulation is imposed pursuant to this subsection (4), notice thereof shall be given to the alderperson representing the district in which the regulation is imposed.
