The 100,000 gallon Morris Tower was built in 1998 and serves the south central section of the City. In August of 2015, the Utility contracted with Dixon Engineering, Inc. to inspect the tower which identified the coating systems have exceeded their life cycle.

On February 2, 2018, proposals for professional services associated with review of specifications for repainting, bid review and recommendation, and performing inspections for the Morris Tower Repainting were sent to four firms. Proposals were due on February 16, 2018. A summary is shown below.
