

Subject:

Rescind the existing August 5, 2004 designation of 2 Hour Parking, 7am to 7pm, Except Sundays and Holidays on east side of Gaspar Street from W. Main Street to W. Broadway.

Details:

This item was referred by Public Works. The City is in the process of reconstructing South Street and Gaspar Street. The proposed street improvements will require several existing parking zones to be removed and several new parking zones to be formed.

This item is to rescind the existing 2 hour parking zone on the east side of Gaspar Street. The new city street layout in this area will remove parking from this side of the street. The Department of Public Works recommends removal of this parking zone.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

Options & Alternatives:

Numerous options were considered in 2015 when engineering and planning examined the ultimate street width of Gaspar Street and it was decided to remove parking in favor of a wider sidewalks.

Financial Remarks:

The signs from the old parking zone will be removed by the construction contractor or by City garage staff at no cost.

Executive Action:

If approved by Council, the resolution for approving the installation of these signs will need to be executed by the Mayor and Clerk after the Council Meeting.

Committee Recommendation:

The Buildings and Grounds Committee approved this item at their April 2, 2018, meeting. This item will appear under the Consent Agenda for the April 17, 2018, Council meeting.
