## A Resolution Authorizing the Sale of Fermented Malt Beverages in City Parks by City Employees and Officers

**Whereas** the Department of Parks, Recreation and Forestry sponsors programs and events in City parks at which the sale of fermented malt beverages is appropriate; and

**Whereas** Wisconsin Statutes §125.06(6) provides that no license or permit for the sale of fermented malt beverages is required if the sales take place in a City park, the sales are conducted by employees or officers of the City, and the sales are authorized by an ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation enacted by the Common Council; and

Whereas the Common Council wish to authorize such sales;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha that:

The sale of fermented malt beverages without permit or license in City parks by employees or officers of the City is authorized, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §125.06(6).
