

Subject:

Approval of contract between City of Waukesha and The Park Foundation of Waukesha, Inc. for Beverage Services at Cutler Park for the Carl Zach Cycling Classic Music Program and approval of related temporary class B liquor license application.

Details:

In conjunction with the Carl Zach Cycling Classic event on June 24, 2018, live music will be performed at the Les Paul Performance Center in Cutler Park. For enhancement of the event, staff is requesting approval of the contract and related liquor license to allow The Park Foundation of Waukesha to sell beverages, including fermented malt beverages during the concerts. Proceeds from the sales benefit the Park Foundation, which in turn benefit City of Waukesha parks.

Options & Alternatives:

Alternatives include not allowing beverage sales during the concerts, which could adversely affect attendance and success of the concert.

Financial Remarks:

The concerts will be funded by sponsor dollars. Proceeds from the beverage sales benefit the Park Foundation, which in turn, benefit City of Waukesha parks. Expenses related to the concerts are anticipated to be \$1,000 and will be paid out of account 5993-53957. Sponsorship revenue account is 5993-48501.

Executive Recommendation:

Recommend approval of temporary class B liquor license application and contract between City of Waukesha and The Park Foundation of Waukesha, Inc. and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to enter into this contract.
