

Subject:

Review and Act on a request by the police department to accept the donation of an armored utility vehicle (Humvee) from the Wisconsin 10-33 Program.

Details:

The Police Department is seeking the Finance Committee and the Common Council approval to accept an armored utility vehicle (Humvee) from the Wisconsin 10-33 program. The vehicle would be used at high risk incidents to protect officers and citizens. This armored vehicle would be in addition to our current ER-50 (MRAP) we received from the 10-33 program. This vehicle is smaller, more maneuverable, requires very little training to operate, and can be brought to a scene in much less time. A detailed description of the vehicle is below:

Armor: Up to 7.62mm armor piercing rounds, 12 pound anti-tank mines. Water Rescue Capabilities: Can ford up to 30 inches of water.

Options & Alternatives:

Not accept the donation of the Humvee and hope we can utilize the ER-50 for all necessary high-risk incidents.

Financial Remarks:



There is no cost for the Humvee. Maintenance and a delivery fee will be minimal, and will be paid for out our vehicle maintenance account (2155.52410), with no increase necessary.
