Subject:

Approve 4 Hour Parking, 7AM to 7PM, Except Sundays and Holidays on the west side of N. East Avenue from 30 feet north to 120 feet north of center line of Alley 017.

Details:

This item was referred by Public Works on behalf of Ald. Helgestad. E. Main Street will be partially reconstructed in 2018 and Public Works has redesigned the street layout at the intersection of E. Main & N. East Avenue. The changes present an opportunity to provide more parking on N. East Avenue adjacent to the Waukesha County museum. The Department of Public Works supports this additional parking change.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

Options & Alternatives:

Leave it as No Parking. Upon review of physical street space, some parking can be accommodated.

Financial Remarks:

The cost to add the signing will be \$200.00 and covered by the CIP fund for this improvement work. Acct. No. 2010.68290.

If approved by Council, the resolution for approving the installation of these signs will need to be executed by the Mayor and Clerk after the Council Meeting.
