- (1) Authorized Representative. A Person who is legally authorized to act on behalf of a User. For purposes of this Chapter, Authorized Representatives for various entities are as follows.eligible to sign and certify reports and submittals required by this Chapter, or to act on behalf of their Facility regarding matters of compliance with this Chapter. An Authorized Representative shall meet the following criteria:
 - (A) If the User is a corporation:, the following are considered Authorized Representatives.
 - 1. A president, secretary, treasurer, vice president in charge of a principal business function, or any other Person who performs similar policy or decision-making functions for the corporation;
 - 2. The manager of one or more manufacturing Facilities provided:
 - <u>a.</u><u>+</u>The manager is authorized to
 - i. <u>mM</u>ake decisions which govern the operation of the Facility,
 - <u>ii.</u> <u>-mM</u>ake major capital investment recommendations, <u>and</u>
 - <u>iii.</u> <u>-iI</u>nitiate and direct comprehensive measures to assure long-term compliance with environmental laws.</u>
 - b. The manager, can ensure the necessary systems are established to gather complete and accurate information for the preparation and submittal of reports.
 - 2.<u>c.</u>, and where a<u>A</u>uthority to sign documents has been delegated to the manager according to the corporation's procedures.;
 - 3. A representative of a Person described in subsections (b)(3)(A)1 or (b)(3)(A)2, above, if the representative has been authorized according to par. subsection (b)(3)(D), below.
 - (B) If the User is a partner, a A-general partner. or proprietor, if the Industrial User is a partnership or
 - 4.(C) If the User is a sole proprietorship, the sole proprietorship, respectively; or.
 - 5.(D) A representative to whom authority has been delegated, if such representative is responsible for (i) the overall operation of the Facility

from which the Discharge into the System originates, or (ii) the overall environmental matters for the Facility, such as a corporate environmental officer. Initially and as circumstances change, a written delegation of authority shall be submitted to the Control Authority.
