<b>Subject:</b> Modify existing parking prohibition on the south side of Perkins Avenue from White Rock to E. Main Street to allow parking on the south side from 50 feet east to 300 feet east of centerline of Adams Street.	

**Details:**

This item was referred by Public Works and Ald. Rodriguez. Residents on the south side of Perkins Avenue would like street parking to be allowed in front of their homes east of Adams Street. The north side of Perkins in this area has No Parking any time. It is staff's conclusion that there won't be any issues with truck movements at the plant and person parking on the south side of Perkins Avenue east of Adams Street. The department of Public Works does not have an issue with this item.
